2014 OBELISCO Electrum Cabernet Sauvignon

AVA: Red Mountain

Winemakers: Doug Long, Pete Hedges, Sarah Goedhart Blend: 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7.5% Merlot, 2.5% Malbec

> Vineyards: 100% Obelisco Bottling: 496 cases 750ml 50 Magnums

Alcohol: 15% vol.

Barrels: 30% new oak; 100% French

Tasting Notes: Dark purple, red color. Dark blackberry fruit aromas with mincemeat spice, black and red licorice and a sweet vanilla toast background. On the palate this wine is full, rich, and slightly sweet with blackberry fruit, mincemeat spice, toasted oak and hints of custard, clove and wet earth. The mouth feel is lush and smooth on the entry and in the mid-palate and finishes long with nicely balanced acid and noticeable tannins, which make for a long, long finish.

Cellaring: Because it is made from Red Mountain grapes this wine should age well for the next 10 to 15 years. Because it is Obelisco fruit, it is soft and inviting now for wine that is 90% Cabernet.



2014 OBELISCO Malbec

AVA: Red Mountain

Winemakers: Sarah Goedhart, Pete Hedges, Doug Long

Blend: 86% Malbec, 14% Cabernet Sauvignon Vineyards: 100% Obelisco

Bottling: 347 cases 750ml Alcohol: 13.7% vol.

Barrels: 30% new oak, 100% French

Tasting Notes: Deep, dark red-purple color. Very pure aromas of black cherry and dried basil shine through, with undertones of cocoa powder, clove, vanilla and cola. On the palate the wine is medium to full-bodied. It is slightly sweet consisting of dried herb notes, dark cherry, pie cherry fruit, slight vanilla toast with a slightly tart mid-palate and a long, soft finish. It's a pleasure to smell and drink. Yummy.

Cellaring: This wine is drinking well now, especially if you like to sniff and sniff and sniff again to smell the ever-evolving aromatics. It will be interesting to see how the intense fruit of this wine changes with age. This is a Malbec, and is well known for its great softness and fruit. It is also 100% Red Mountain, which is known for its longer-aged wines. We're guessing this wine should be a good cellar ager. The Cabernet added to the mix will bring on the longevity a bit more. We are continually pleased with how consistently good the Red Mountain Malbec has become.



2014 OBELISCO Merlot

AVA: Red Mountain

Winemakers: Doug Long , Sarah Goedhart Blend: 81% Merlot, 19% Cabernet Vineyards: 100% Obelisco

Bottling: 198 cases 750ml Alcohol: 13.7% vol.

Barrels: 60% new - 40% new French, 20% new Am. & 40% Neutral American.

Tasting Notes: Beautiful deep red color. On the nose, the aroma is full of red berries, herbs and hints of citrus peel, dark floral notes with slight perfume. On the palate this wine is full, rich and surprisingly bright with flavors of raspberries, cherries, sage spice with inklings of cinnamon and vanilla. The mouth feel is soft, with satisfying structure, with a full, long, yet slightly sweet finish that endures with nicely balanced acid and tannins.

Cellaring: Because it is made from Red Mountain Merlot and Cabernet this wine should age well for the next 10 to 12 years. Because it is Obelisco fruit it is soft and inviting now.
