Tasting Notes: Big aromas of Meyer lemon with hints of floral and jasmine with Subtle Asian fruit tones, lychee, fresh cut apples and Citrus Blossom. On the palate it displays a balance of lively flavors starting with sweet lemon with a nice background of stone fruit followed by a great elevated natural acidity finish characteristic of the vintage.

Harvest: 2013 was one of the most bountiful harvests for almost all vineyards in Washington State. Fruit from all over the region matured in ideal conditions and produced good numbers in volume and fantastic flavors. It was an iconic growing season. Obelisco chose Dineen vineyard fruit that showed over other vineyards with more depth and complexity.

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
