



## 2012 Cabernet Rose'

**Blend:** 100% Cabernet

**Tasting Notes:** Deep pomegranate red color and captivating aromas of strawberry and watermelon fill the glass. Medium weight in the mouth with waves of bright strawberry, pomegranate and watermelon that roll across the tongue. Mouth watering acidity dances on the tongue complimenting the juicy finish.

**Harvest:** Behind the beautiful crimson color lies the juice of 100% Estate Cabernet from Obelisco. 2012 was one of the most bountiful harvests for almost all vineyards in Washington State. Fruit from all over the region matured in ideal conditions and produced good numbers in volume and fantastic flavors. That being said, the fruit from the Obelisco vineyard was a step above other vineyards with more depth and complexity. This is a result of the location on Red Mountain as well as the intense density of the vines at the Obelisco Vineyard.

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
